How to request Instrumental Tuition

Please be aware that there may be a waiting list in place for some instruments, if this is the case your son or daughter will be informed. Once the request form has been processed you will be contacted by the Instrumental Tutor or a member of staff.

Payment

Approximately 30 lessons are given each year, which vary in length depending on the tutor and the student. Instrumental tutors will submit their invoice to parents each term and any necessary adjustments will be made in the following term. Rates for lessons are fixed by each tutor and parents will be informed of the rate the tutor intends to charge (usually in the region of £12 - £16 per lesson depending on duration).

Cancelling Tuition

One months written notice, given to both the instrumental tutor and the Music Department will be required before lessons will be cancelled.
