

# Homework

In Semester 2 - in response to feedback from staff, students and parents - the Academy has moved away from setting Independent Learning Tasks in all subjects. Instead, homework will be a combination of longer and shorter pieces, set at the class teacher's discretion.

All homework is set on ClassCharts so that students and parents are clear what it is they have to do and when the work has to be completed by. Any additional resources students may need will be uploaded.

The class teacher will also log on ClassCharts whether or not homework has been submitted. Parents can therefore check whether their son/daughter is completing homework on time, and what work they have to do at any given point.

	<b><i>What will happen if my son/daughter does not complete their homework?</i></b>
1	The class teacher will sign the student's conduct card in the Equipment section. They will write: H/wk, their staff initials and the date.
2	Either a new deadline for the homework will be set or the class teacher will ask the student to see them at a convenient time for additional support.
3	If homework is still not completed by the extended deadline, or the student fails to come and see the teacher as arranged, another strike will be added to

	the student's conduct card.
4	Regular failure to complete homework may therefore result in the student sitting an after school detention.
5	Repeated failure to complete homework, homework handed in late or homework completed to a poor standard, will be reflected in a student's Learning Behaviours PRAG on the report at the end of each semester. Prior to this point, class teachers or tutors may contact parents/carers to make them aware of their concerns.
