Focus on: Careers


Over the past two days Plympton Academy have held a careers festival, with a wide variety of activities taking place. On Thursday Year 7 and 8 took part in a British Aerospace / RAF workshop exploring a variety of careers in STEM whilst all students had the opportunity to visit the careers fayre in the Sports Hall where over 20 different employers, colleges and universities including Falmouth and Plymouth University; the RAF; Devon and Cornwall Police and Lorne Stewart ran stalls where students could find out about the wide range of career opportunities in the South West. On Friday we were very fortunate to welcome the BBC Bitesize Careers Roadshow to the school. 
